Dear Parents and Carers,

## Home Visits

## Timings

Children will then officially start school on **Tuesday 2nd September** and come to us initially for mornings from **8.45-11.30** through to **Wednesday 10th September**. On **Thursday 11th September and Friday 12th September**, children will stay for lunch and finish at **12.30** and from **Monday 15th September** children will start full time, **8.30 - 3.10**.

On your child's 1st day of school, **Tuesday 2nd September**, the PFA would like to invite all parents and carers to the school hall for a coffee and a chat! This will start as soon as you've dropped your child off at 8.45 and finish at 10.00. We'd love to see you all there!
