I am delighted to announce that Musical Village will be running an **after-school Pop Stars Club** for children in **Years 2, 3, and 4** at Kirby Muxloe Primary School this half term.

My name is Lesia Smaditch, and I have been involved in organising and leading various musical activities for children over the past 20 years. The **Pop Stars Club** is a lively and confidence building music club for children in **Years 2, 3 and 4** where children can sing, dance and shine like real pop stars. Each week the children learn well known songs, try simple dance moves and enjoy taking turns with the microphone. The club is all about having fun, building confidence and enjoying music together.

Children do not need to be strong singers to join. Everyone can take part in their own way. Some children enjoy singing, some prefer dancing and some like using percussion instruments. The club is fully inclusive and suitable for all abilities.

What the children will do each week:

- Warm up games to get everyone moving
- Learn a popular song with simple actions
- Try easy choreography
- Take turns in the Pop Star Spotlight
- Work together as a group
- Build confidence

The Pop Stars Club will run on Thursdays from 3.10 to 4.00p.m for four weeks starting on Thursday 11th June. The sessions will take place in one of the school classrooms and children will need to be collected from reception at the end of each session.
