Dear Parents and Carers,

Our first 2 weeks have sped by and children are already back into their routines. Our new reception children have only been in a few days, but are already beginning to settle in.

I have been really pleased with how well children (and parents) have taken to the new snacks and packed lunch guidance. It has been transformational and I know that this will not only help reinforce healthy eating messages, but also support positive behaviour. I would like to thank you all for your support with this, it has made everything much easier. Please do contact me if you would like any clarification on any of the food items. I am aware that we may not have covered everything and am always happy to provide a little further detail.

A reminder about not booking holidays during term time, I appreciate the reasons for this (cost/ time availability of relatives etc.) but I am unable to authorise holidays and if they are of a certain length, I am required to refer to the local authority for a fine (for clarification, we don't see any of this money). Please let other relatives know of our term dates so they avoid booking anything inadvertently. I am hoping to update you on next year's term dates soon, so please watch out for this.

I would like to also mention parental parking before and after the school day. I am very aware of the time pressures and individual needs of children and the pressures this puts on people wanting to park near to the school. I would ask you, though, to seriously consider where you park to ensure that you are parked safely and considerately for everyone else. Parking on double yellow lines (unless you have a disabled badge) can lead to parking fines and traffic wardens do patrol periodically. I would particularly ask that you do not park in front of resident's driveways. I know that some people feel that, 'if you live near a school, you know what you're getting' but it is something I would never do personally and would ask that you don't either. Additionally, I know that things can get a little heated during this time and I would ask you to remain calm in these situations and help to model our school values of kindness and respect so that our children can come to and from school surrounded by positivity and courtesy. I really appreciate your support with this.

It has been great to see so many of you coming in for our meet and greet sessions and if you were unable to, I would urge you to check out the presentations that were shared. It has also been lovely meeting some of our new parents and carers. I hope you all have a lovely weekend.
