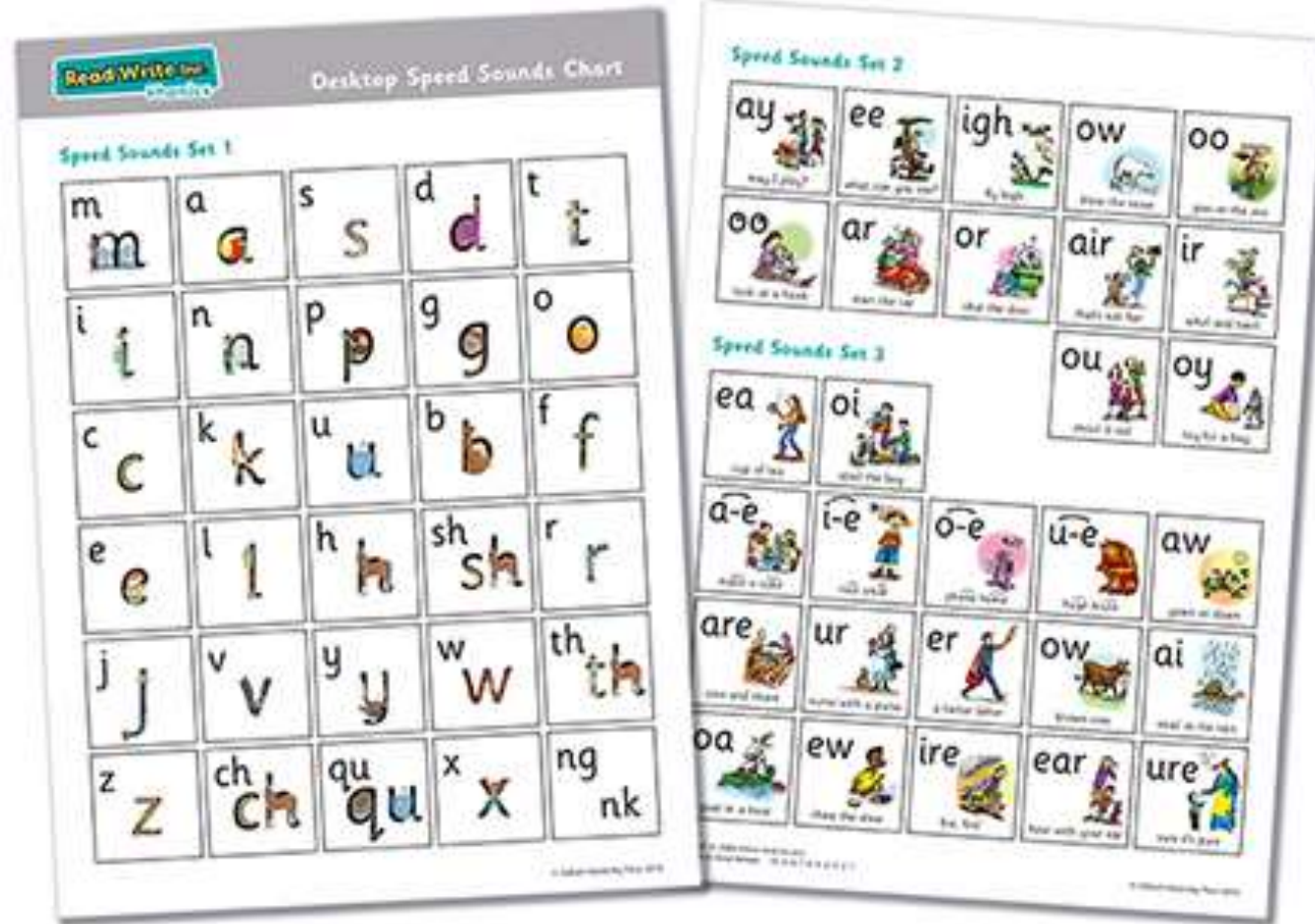

Assessment

- Children's progress is assessed every six weeks.
- Children read sounds, real and alien words with a familiar adult.
- If the child is confident in reading and using the sounds they've been learning, they'll move onto the next group and set of sounds.
- Towards the end of the phonics programme, reading fluency is also assessed.

Reading at Home

- Extensive research has shown that reading at home with their child is the single most important thing parents can do to improve educational achievement.
- Our home reading books are closely matched to the phonics sounds and books your child is learning each week in school. Reception will also bring home a story book for you to read to them.
- It is recommended that children read each book 3-5 times. This helps them progress from focussing on decoding to focussing on comprehension.
- Remember: PRACTICE MAKES PERMANENT! 😊
- We'd really like it if you could send us a short video (30-60 seconds) of your child reading to someone at home on Seesaw (Y1) or Tapestry (YR). It doesn't need to be the whole book, just a few pages and we'll award 10 house points for every video we receive!
- Books will be changed every Thursday in Year 1 and on Friday in Reception, please remember to bring them in.
