Dear Parents and Carers

I would like to ask for your support in being good neighbours to our local community and keeping everyone safe before and after school.

We have had reports of people parking inconsiderately and sometimes dangerously when dropping children off and picking children up before and after school. This has included:

- Parking across or in people's private driveways meaning they cannot get out to work
- Parking on the corners of junctions, making it dangerous to cross the road
- Parking on yellow lines
- Turning in the Croft (a private road) that many pedestrians use to get to and from school

With the weather so unpleasant at the moment, it has a double effect:

- 1) That visibility is poor for pedestrians and drivers (particularly when reversing)
- 2) That people are more tempted to park in the wrong places.

Please leave more time and park in the designated local car parks and parking spaces or walk to school. This will help keep everyone safer and happier.
