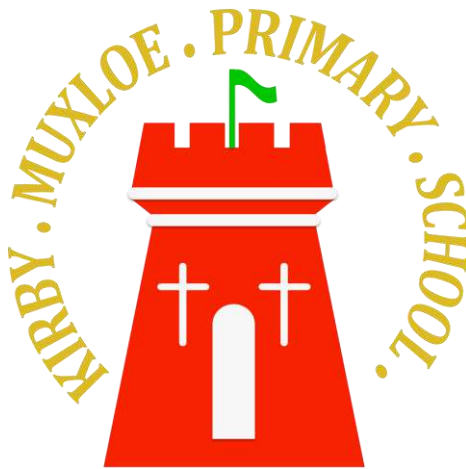

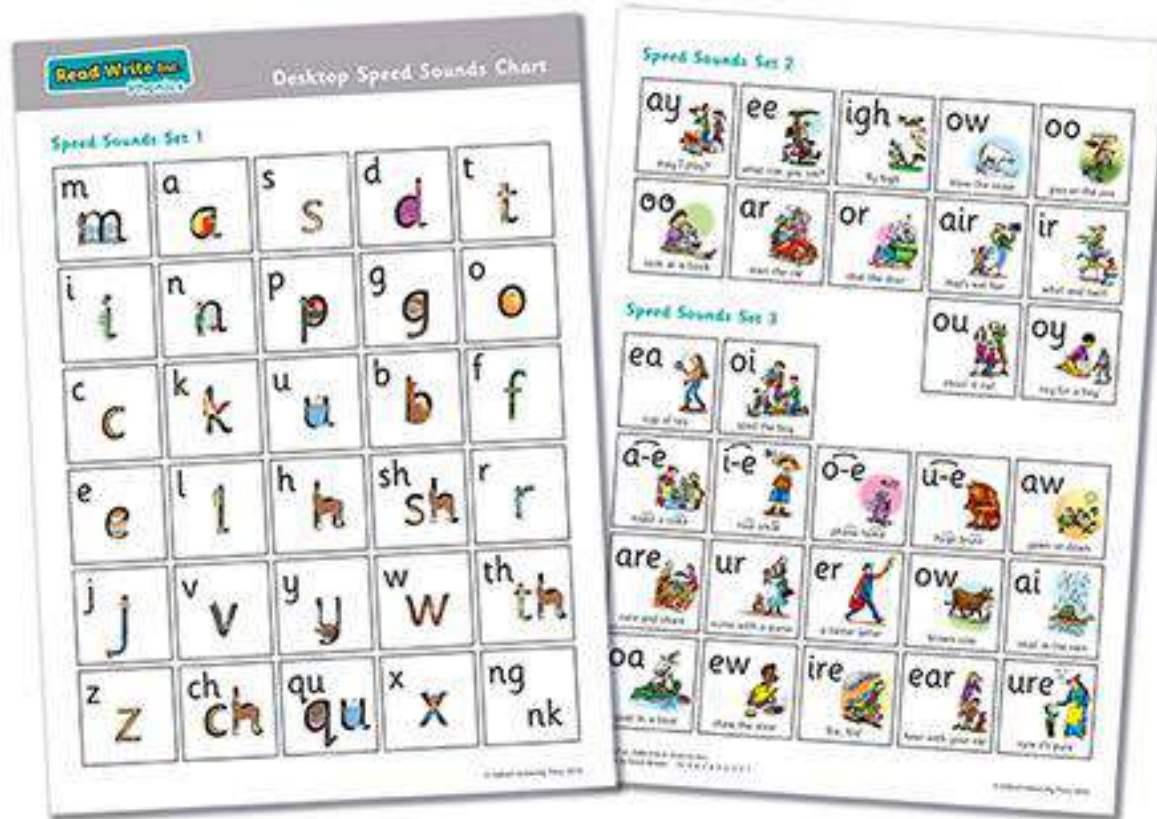

Progression of Sounds

Level	Speed Sounds to Teach, Review and Say
A— Speed Sounds	Teach: m a s d t i n p g o c k u b f e l h s h r j v w
B— Ditties/ Red	Teach: th z ch qu x ng nk ck Recap: A
C—Green	Teach: ay ee igh ow (blow) oo oo Recap: A, B and C
D—Pink/ Purple	Teach: or ar air ir ou oy ow Recap: C and D Sing the Alphabet Song
E/F— Orange/ Yellow	Teach: Letter Names, a-e ea i-e o-e u-e, oi (remind children these are also sounds when not split e.g ue in glue.) ur ai oa—ready for screening Recap: A–D
G—Blue	Teach: au (not in pack) aw are ur er ow ai oa ew ire ear ure tion cious/tious Recap: C–F
H—Grey	Teach: e ie ue ue au, suffixes ing, ed, s, er, est and prefixes dis, un Recap: C–F

Assessment

- Children's progress is assessed every six weeks.
- Children read sounds, real and alien words with a familiar adult.
- If the child is confident in reading and using the sounds they've been learning, they'll move onto the next group and set of sounds.
- Towards the end of the phonics programme, reading fluency is also assessed.

Reading at Home

- Extensive research has shown that reading at home with their child is the single most important thing parents can do to improve educational achievement.
- Our home reading books are closely matched to the phonics sounds and books your child is learning each week in school.
- It is recommended that children read each book 3-5 times. This helps them progress from focussing on decoding to focussing on comprehension.
- Remember: PRACTICE MAKES PERMANENT! 😊
- We'd really like it if you could send us a short video (30-60 seconds) of your child reading to someone at home on Seesaw. It doesn't need to be the whole book, just a few pages and we'll award 10 house points for every video we receive!
- Books will be changed every Friday in Year 1 and on set days in Reception, please remember to bring them in.
