Year 4 York Residential Trip 2025

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing regarding the Year 4 residential trip for 2025. We are very much looking forward to returning to the historic city of York, a city that provides many rich links to the Y4 curriculum.

The plan is as follows:

- Thursday 19th and Friday 20th June 2025
- 2 days/1 night duration
- Accommodation in the York Racing Stables visitor accommodation, a purpose-built facility on the outskirts of York. All rooms are modern, en-suite & we have visited it many times before.
- Itinerary is expected to comprise visits to:
 - The Jorvik Centre
 - York's Chocolate Story
 - York Minster Cathedral
 - Viking Activity Day at Murton Park (near York)
- The cost for this visit will be approximately **£135 - £145** but may alter slightly due to the number of children who attend. The cost covers accommodation, transport to and from venues, entrance fees, guides and meals (except breakfast and lunch on the Thursday) and we think the trip offers a great learning and cultural experience for fantastic value.

Please confirm your child's attendance and pay your initial deposit of **£20** using our on-line payment system **by Monday 7th October**.

A second payment of £45 will be due by Monday 3rd February 2025 and the final payment (amount to be confirmed but expected to be between £70 - £80) will be due by Friday 2nd May 2025.

Parents, whose children are eligible for the Pupil Premium or receive certain state benefits, will be able to receive support with costs. Please contact us if not sure or if you are facing financial hardship or other barriers to attending as we always want to take all of the children with us.

The trip will be led by myself and I will be accompanied by other members of staff. I hope your child will be able to join us. Should you have any questions about the trip, please speak to me or one of the class teachers (all of whom have been before) via the school office.
